Cranes can also be transported to various construction sites on the road as they drive themselves, which eliminates the need for extra transport vehicles. One disadvantage of a truck crane is that it is not stable enough sitting on tires alone in order to be able to lift the major loads that a hydraulic crane could handle. Thus, in order to fix this issue, outriggers can be extended from the deck. The outriggers use hydraulic pressure in order to slightly lift the truck off of the ground, making it stable and balanced. The crawler crane is unique in that it has big tracks on the base of the crane. These huge tracks are very like bulldozers and backhoes. The tracks enable the crane to move around a construction site successfully.
